
The Future of Surgery is here

Optimizing surgical workflow

The Perioperative Care Unit nears completion.
The new Perioperative Care Unit (PCU) will have
40 universal, pre and post-operative patient bays
including a negative pressure isolation room. Walls
with sliding doors featuring e-glass instead of
curtains between bays provide improved infection
control, acoustics and patient privacy.
